

SUPPLEMENTARY OBLIGATIONS TO THE COPYING LICENCE TERMS FOR THE LICENSEE

Licensee's obligations and responsibilities

The licensee has a responsibility to ensure that the data network used by them corresponds to the definition of a closed network, as defined in the licence terms. The licensee must inform its staff of the content and terms of the licence.

Liability of Kopiosto

Kopiosto assumes liability for those justifiable claims that are brought forth by a copyright holder that is not part of Kopiosto or its member organisation for any copying carried out during the validity of the copying licence and in accordance with the licence terms.

Reporting copies and participation in copying surveys

Kopiosto informs the licensee of the manner in which digital copies made in accordance with the copying licence may be reported. The licensee commits to participating in the survey, followup and reporting of copying activities when requested, and to providing Kopiosto with the necessary information. The survey and reporting data is used to distribute the remunerations to the copyright holders in accordance with the terms of the copying licence.

Right of inspection

Kopiosto, or a party authorised by Kopiosto, has the right to inspect the copies stored under the copying licence on the storage platforms or the closed network used by the licensee, as well as other copying arrangements. Furthermore, Kopiosto has the right to request that the licensee provide a report on the application of the copying terms in the licensee's operations.

Activities in violation of the licence terms

Kopiosto has the right to cancel the licence granted to the licensee with immediate effect should the licensee violate the licence terms or fail to pay remunerations in accordance with the invoice. Activities in violation of the licence and the Copyright Act may lead to liability to compensate and pay damages, as well as other penalties set out in the Copyright Act.

The validity of the licence

These supplementary obligations are valid until further notice from 1 January 2023 onwards.
