We distribute the remunerations we collect both directly to creative industry professionals and our member organisations, who then distribute them forward in the form of grants and awards, for instance. Some of the funds are distributed as various grants for the audiovisual industry through the Promotion Centre for Audiovisual Culture AVEK, which operates as a part of Kopiosto.

The remunerations we collect and distribute are based on research data. We study the use of works at educational institutions, organisations and public administration comprehensively.

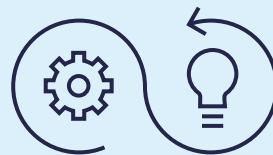
